SAMPLE ITINERARY: COLLEGE VETERINARY SERVICE

This page will give you an idea of what a typical version of this program looks like. Animal needs, weather, sanctuary demands, holidays, and any number of other factors can affect your itinerary, so you should think of this itinerary as a sample more than a plan. The order of the two weeks may vary. Your time in each location will be a mix of classroomstyle time with your vet, hands-on veterinary activities, hands-on animal care and shelter upkeep activities, and tourist activities.

Sunday: Arrive, welcome talk and safety orientation, Sunday street market for dinner and exploring.

<u>Monday - Friday</u> of ARK week: Breakfast will be at home, with departure around 8:30am. There will be a lunch break around noon. We will return home between 5pm and 6pm for a short break, and then go to dinner and evening activities.
